

# Birtle Fire Department responds to house fire

Birtle and District Volunteer Fire Department were called to respond to a fire at Mike Mychasiw's residence at 5:40 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 22 amidst heavy rain and sleet.

The fire, suspected to have started from an electrical problem, originated in the attached garage and damaged the wall of the house and the garage, with a minimal amount of damage also occurring in the attic.

The fire was put out very quickly and although Mutual Aid had been alerted and was on standby, it was not necessary to call in other departments, according to Birtle Fire Chief, Gerald Birch.
